2nd ANNUAL HIGH SCHOOL READINESS CAMP

Meadowcreek High School is excited to offer our 2nd annual *High School Readiness Camp*. This two-part camp is intended to provide rising 9th graders with an opportunity to gain the necessary skills for success in high school.

- **Students may opt to attend only one or both parts of the camp**
- **Both parts of the camp are completely free of charge**
- **Transportation will be available if needed**

Readiness Camp – Part 1

Dates: June 7 – July 15 **no class on July 5th

Days: Monday – Thursday (no class on Fridays)

Hours: 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. (Lunch and transportation provided)

Health and Introduction to Lifetime Fitness

During Part 1, students will have an opportunity to earn a full credit for two graduation requirements, Health and Introduction to Lifetime Fitness. Taking these classes during the summer will allow students to free up space in their schedules to take another elective course during their 9th grade year. These classes usually cost **\$225** per class during the summer but will be offered **free of charge** to Meadowcreek High School's rising 9th grade students. Because students will have an opportunity to earn credits for these courses, there is a strict attendance policy. **Students will not be permitted to miss more than 2 days for any reason.**

Readiness Camp – Part 2

Dates: July 19 – July 29

Days: Monday – Thursday (no class on Fridays)

Hours: 7:00 a.m. – 2:15 p.m. (Lunch and transportation provided)

During Part 2, students will be receiving intensive academic skill preparation geared toward success in high school. Students will follow a specified schedule rotating through the core areas (Math, Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies). Students will also take a High School Survival Course to learn time management skills, test taking strategies, study techniques, and other critical components to being successful in high school.

We are very excited to be able to provide this opportunity. However, we need your participation in order for us to be able to offer this camp.
